allied (generically) to *M. A. P.*
no. 791 collected by Dr.
Bex and which is not
a good *Asterina*. Near
Dactylidia but differs in
having a perithecium.

Do you think 3693 is
really the *Periza pulveracea*
A. & S.? It has been so
considered but "*basi nigra*
stipitata" does not apply and
it is really *cespitosa* - See *A. & S.*
"*in cespitibus non colligitur*".
