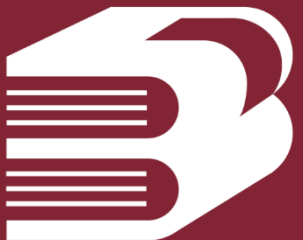
Opportunities

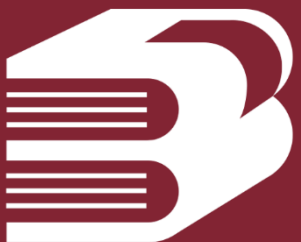

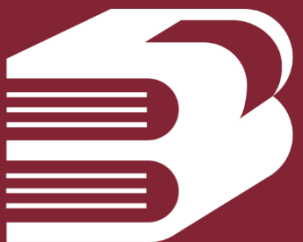


Sapienza Digital Scientific Journals

There are currently **20+ OA journals**, among which some are scans of printed journals

2.4.8.3 OJS version in use. **3.1.1.0** will be activated soon



Project goals

- 50+ OA journals by the university departments in OJS
- Policy to invite journals to add OJS the OA digital version
- OA principles and practice promotion plan
- Help to journals to be indexed in Scopus, WoS, DOAJ, etc.
- Integration between Sapienza digital library (SDL) and IRIS (already planned)
- Definition of a long-term preservation policy

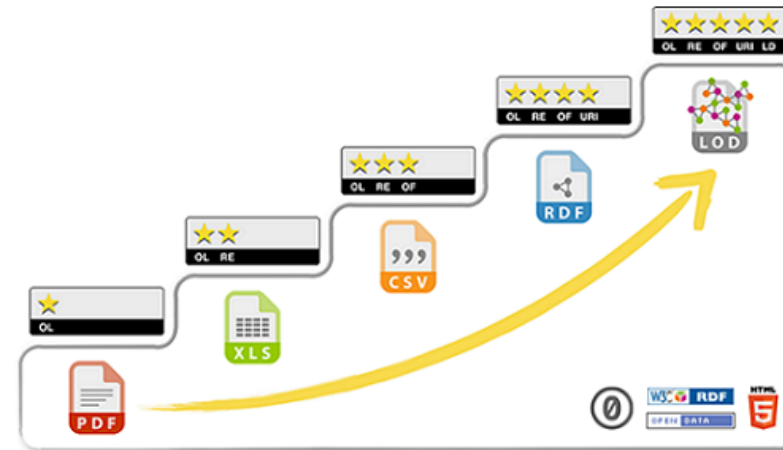

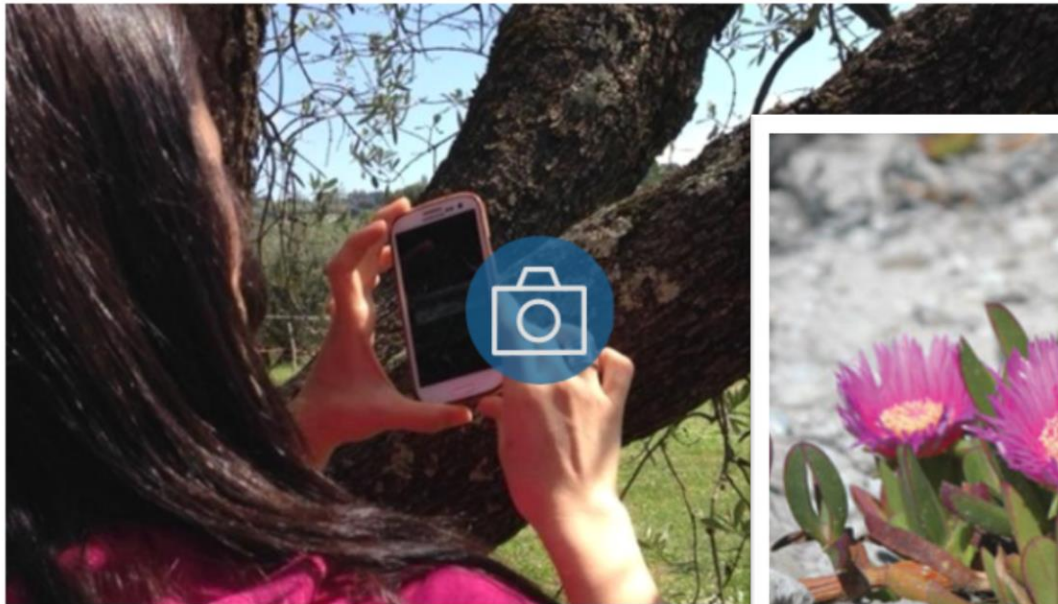
