Dear Sir: Along with
this I send you by mail a pack-
age of specimens of Myxomyces.
I would like to make an exchange
with you or with some one through
you, for the Myxomyces of Italy,
and I offer these specimens, I
send you, as an example of how
I will put them up. I can offer
for exchange about 100 species
which grow in this vicinity (
(Cincinnati, Ohio, U.S.A.)

I would be pleased furthermore
to send you the Myxomyces of
this region in order to obtain your
opinion on such species as we
are accustomed to consider

identical with European forms.

There has been, as yet, very little critical study of N. A. Myxomyces and it is very probable that we have made many mistakes.

In this package which I now send you, I am very doubtful of the specimen labeled Circospora reticulata, N. & S. and I am not sure of Filmodocha columbina Berk nor of Curatricha Frisiciana, Det.

I will be greatly obliged for all correction of errors; and should I send you anything new, you are at liberty to name and describe it.
