I herewith
acknowledge the receipt of Vol. II.
Sylloge Fungorum, for which
I send Post Office Order for
60 francs in payment.

I also inclose to you some of
the original specimens of "Sphaeria
Coulteri Pk.", which you place
in Enchnospheeria Vol. II p. 207, but
with doubt if it is an Eriosphaeria.

I believe it to be the same
that Cooke has under "Lasiosphaeria
acicola" Grev. VIII p. 87, = Amphisphaeria?
acicola Sacc. Vol. I p. 727.

It does not seem to go well in either genus.
Not Amphisphaeria for the perithecia are
not glabrous; not Enchnospheeria nor
Eriosphaeria for the spores are not

hyaline. What can be done
with it?

I mailed to you two days ago
two Reports and a copy of the Torrey
Bulletin with descriptions of some
new species of fungi.
