Dear Doctor Saccardo:

The Reprint and cards which you kindly sent were received and read with much pleasure.

With this mail I send you another package of specimens for determination and correction.

I wish to correct a mistake in the determination of the host plant of (~~####~~) No. 985. *Septoria psammophila* Sacc. on *Psoralea lanceolata* Pursh. Among the specimens now being sent are several fungi on *Astragalus pectinatus*.

My usual professional work has kept me so busy that I have not been able to send fungi more frequently. We have had a very wet season which is most favorable for the fungi and I should be able to get many more species. I am contemplating a trip to other parts of our state to collect specimens and will then send you parts of all collections.

Some days ago I received an announcement of the death of Dr. H. Rehm. He died on Apr. 1/16 in his 88th year.
