

I, of course, understand that it will take some time to make these identifications, but as soon as they are made, if you so desire, we can publish them here in the Journal of Science. I was also very much pleased to learn of your progress with the collections from the Philippines. This summer I am going to make a trip to Siam and intend to make a collection of fungi from that region. If you are interested in them I shall be more than pleased to send the entire collection to you. This work is being done in cooperation with the United States Department of Agriculture, so consequently I should like determinations of these Siamese forms as soon as it is possible for you to make them.

I shall include in the publication on Chinese fungi the note which you gave in your card.
